

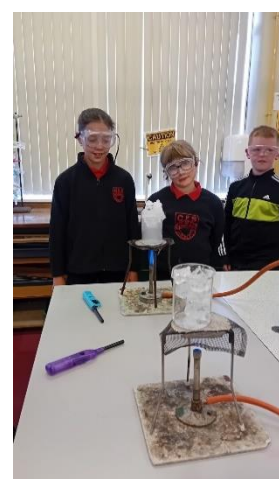
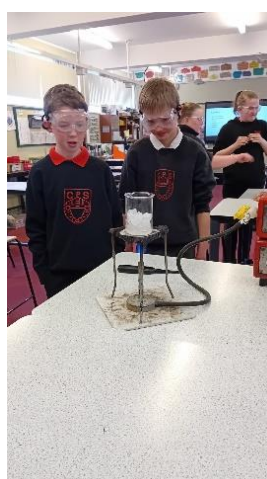
Dear Parents / Carers
